### **Continuing the Work**

Per the IFC Constitution, Chancellor Nasser Paydar gave the annual State of the Campus address on November 17, 2020.

The Faculty Census was presented on March 2, 2021, and can be found attached to the minutes of that meeting.

The Office of Academic Affairs began a review of potential modifications to promotion, tenure, and merit criteria. The IFC reviewed recommendations and approved the modifications on May 4, 2021. The

modifications allowed for the approved Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Case Type for promotion and tenure.

A global pandemic (COVID-19) continued from spring 2020 and ended most normal campus operations, including the IUPUI Faculty Council. All meetings of the Faculty Council and the Faculty Council Executive Committee were held through Zoom from early spring 2020 through May 2021. The IFC operated remotely until August 2021.

The IFC heard a report on the COVID-19 Annual Review Supplement that would help faculty document the challenges of teaching and doing research and service during the pandemic.

The IFC Executive Committee approved two “wellness days” during the spring 2021 semester to create an opportunity for students to engage with each other.

In support of the university’s mandate that all faculty, staff, and students should be vaccinated to help prevent the spread of COVID-19, the IFC Executive Committee endorsed the following statement: “We, the members of the IUPUI Faculty Council Executive Committee, in wanting to return to a lively campus community, support the full vaccination of the faculty, staff, and students.”
